P5 Adventure Camp 2018

1. We will be conducting an Adventure Camp for Primary 5 pupils from 28 March 2018 (Wednesday, 7.30 a.m.) to 29 March 2018 (Thursday, 5 p.m.). This is a 2-day-1-night adventure camp that aims to provide pupils with opportunities to develop their outdoor adventure skills and leadership qualities.
2. The camp theme, "I A.M. We A.R.E." is crafted as an acronym in-line with the social emotional learning competencies that we are striving to help pupils acquire.
 - a. "I A.M." refers to **SELF**-Awareness and **SELF**-Management
 - b. "WE A.R.E." refers to **SOCIAL** Awareness, Relationship management and rEsponsible decision-making
3. The various activities at the camp will help pupils acquire skills related to these competencies. This camp also aims to provide pupils with many opportunities to acquire new skills and to learn from their peers by sharing the knowledge which they possess. They will also be able to reflect on their experiences at the end of each activity. Through team-building activities, they will develop a positive outlook and learn to make responsible decisions as leaders. We hope that these initiatives will allow our pupils to develop holistically, in-line with our school vision, A Concerned Leader, A Lifelong Learner.

Please note that there will be a **briefing for parents and guardians of campers on Friday, 2 March 2018 from 7 p.m. to 8 p.m. in the school hall** to provide you with more in-depth information about the camp and its activities. There will also be a sale of camping equipment during the briefing but it is **not compulsory for you to buy from the vendor**. Parents and guardians are strongly encouraged to attend the briefing to find out more about the camp and clarify any doubts.

6. Please indicate your attendance at the Parents' Briefing through **Form B** and return it through your child's/ward's Form Teacher by **Thursday, 1 March 2018**.
7. Please indicate your decision for your child/ward to attend the P5 Adventure Camp through the **Reply Slip of the attached Consent Form and Form A**, if your child/ward is attending the camp, and return them through your child's/ward's Form Teacher by **Wednesday, 7 March 2018**.
8. **Pupils who are not attending the camp** must still report to school according to their usual curriculum time on 28 March and 29 March 2018. These pupils are also required to **purchase the red camp T-shirt** as they will be wearing it during the National Education (NE) show in July. The **cost of the T-shirt will be informed at a later date and payable in cash only**.
9. For pupils attending the camp, the **estimated** subsidy and amount payable are as shown below. You will be notified of the payment arrangement for the actual amount through the School Bill at a later date.
