# SUPPORT FROM THE SELF HELP GROUPS











#### **Support from the Self Help Groups:**

Big Heart Student Care is able to harness the resources of the four Self Help Groups (SHG) to provide support and assistance to families in need. The four main forms of support provided are the SHG plug in programmes, Programme Fee Subsidy (PFS), Family Referrals and Parent Engagement Sessions.

## 1.SHG Plug in Programmes

SHGs provide additional **learning support programmes** for students who receive the ComCare Student Care Fee Assistance (SCFA). Students who are enrolled into the programme can attend programmes ranging from homework coaching, learning support programmes as well as additional enrichment programmes and learning journeys.

## 2. SHG Programme Fee Subsidy (PFS)

In 2017, SHGs rolled out the PFS scheme, to provide enhanced subsidies for students who receive the ComCare Student Care Fee Assistance (SCFA). The additional subsidies, on top of SCFA, covers other out-of-pocket expenses related to student care services.

Students can receive **upto \$471** of subsidies in a year to help defray expenses related to Full Day

Programme Fees, Holiday Enrichment Fees, Learning Journey Fees and 2 free sets of Big Heart T-shirts (for FAS students).

## 3. SHG Family Referral Programme

Big Heart Student Care is able to directly refer families in need of additional support, to the respective SHGs. A caseworker from the SHGs will then assess the family's needs through a holistic approach and arrange for the necessary support for the family.

Upon assessment, families may receive support in the form of financial assistance, financial counselling, grocery vouchers, utilities vouchers, Back to School vouchers or job seeking advice and referrals.

## 4. Parent Engagement sessions

SHGs offer parent engagement sessions in the form of workshops and talks. These sessions are open to all parents in SCC and school. Since 2020, the workshops have been conducted online and are provided at no cost.

Workshops range from parenting to family management topics such as 'Disciplining and Managing Children', 'Supporting Children's learning styles' and 'Effective Communication at Home.'
